Question One (1 Mark)

1 mark for circling the correct answer

Question Two (2 Marks)

1 mark for a simple explanation

E.g. It means she views him as someone insignificant who deliberately damages property.

2 marks for a more developed response

E.g. It means she views him as someone insignificant who deliberately damages property. It tells you that she didn't value his art or talent.

Question Three (1 Mark)

1 mark for circling the correct response

difficult to find, catch or achieve

Question Four (1 Mark)

1 mark for identifying the correct word

sublime

Question Five (1 Mark)

1 mark for a relevant explanation

E.g. in my imagination

Question Six (1 Mark)

1 mark for matching the terms and definitions correctly

transfixed - cause someone to become motionless with horror, wonder, or astonishment

quaint - attractively unusual or old-fashioned

juxtaposed - place or deal with close together for contrasting effect

conjured - make something appear unexpectedly or seemingly from nowhere

Question Seven (1 Mark)

1 mark for a relevant explanation or idea

E.g. Many people had gathered/got together to view his work.



Question Eight (2 Marks)

1 mark for each appropriate impression (accept any other relevant impression – up to a maximum of 2 marks):

He is talented.

He is skilful.

He thinks carefully about what he creates.

He wants to create imagery for purpose.
