THE WIZARD OF OZ READING COMPREHENSION – INFERENCE Qs

Question One (1 Mark)

1 mark for recognising 'the lumber had to be carried for many miles'

Question Two (2 Marks)

1 mark for an appropriate reference to the sun

E.g. the sun blistered and baked all of the surroundings until everything was grey, even her lips and eyes.

1 mark for an appropriate reference to the wind/cyclones

E.g. the wind destroyed any chance of happiness and she couldn't find anything to laugh at.

Question Three (1 Mark)

1 mark for recognising 'Dorothy still found things to laugh at'

Question Four (2 Marks)

1 mark for an appropriate emotion

E.g. upset/lonely/miserable

1 mark for an appropriate emotion with justification

E.g. I think she would feel miserable as Toto saved her from growing as grey as her surroundings.

Question Five (1 Mark)

1 mark for a sensible answer

E.g. this suggests he was worried another cyclone was about to come.



Question Six (1 Mark)

1 mark for a justified response

E.g. he needed to tell his wife immediately about the storm that was about to arrive

Question Seven (2 Marks)

1 mark with reference to him being caring/kind

E.g. this suggests that he is very conscientious as he wanted to take care of the stock before saving himself.

1 mark with reference to his job/role around the house

E.g. this suggests he is in charge of looking after and feeding the stock.

Question Eight (2 Marks)

1 mark for a relevant emotion

E.g. scared/petrified/worried/anxious

1 mark for a relevant emotion with justification

E.g. I think she might have felt anxious as she wanted to wait and save Toto but she also knew she had to go and hide in the cellar.
