What work is my child expected to undertake during a day of remote learning?

The school has a duty to offer four hours of learning a day for KS2 children and three hours per day for KS1 & EYFS. We are currently delivering this through a mixture of live sessions and guided afternoon sessions. Parents and carers are doing a fantastic job of supporting learning at home, and we are ever mindful that families have their work to undertake at this time as well.

In terms of completing and submitting work for your child, everyone's circumstances are likely to be different. We record the live sessions and upload all work to the class pages. This way, you can approach the lessons and materials as needed. We realise that some days will be more difficult than others. Please take a measured approach to what you can realistically achieve on each given day. Remember that we are here to support and are just an email or phone call away.

Why can't children have cameras on during the lessons?

As we record the sessions, the video would capture the whole screen, including all active cameras. The resulting video would likely distract from the content and teacher modelling during the session.

Where are the materials for the afternoon lessons located?

Please check your child's class news page on the school website. The page will contain the presentations used in all the live sessions, links to external media and guidance for the afternoon sessions. If you require further support, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher who will be more than happy to help.

Can we upload editable word documents for children to complete?

As we have families accessing the live sessions through a range of different devices, including laptops & tablets, photos are the easiest way to ensure that work can be submitted to class teachers quickly and reliably.
