Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are well and had an enjoyable Easter.

I am writing to give you an update from the Trust which involves us supporting a Telford Primary School. We have been asked as a Trust by the Governors of Queenswood Primary and Telford and Wrekin Council to support Queenswood Primary this term, with the intention of the school becoming part of LCT in September 2022. There is a need to provide leadership support at Queenswood whilst we appoint a new Headteacher to the school which we are currently in the process of undertaking.

Therefore, in agreement with the Chair of Governors and Governors at Crudgington, we have asked Mr Ames to provide Headship support at Queenswood this term. He has very kindly agreed to do this and therefore, will be at Queenswood most mornings and return to Crudgington for the afternoon sessions to ensure the school is working smoothly. We have great confidence in Mr Ames and know he will do this really well for the Trust and Queenswood Primary; it is a very similar size and he will help prepare the school for a new Headteacher. We hope we may have a new Headteacher in post by June, so this is a short-term measure.

Mr Ames will be at Crudgington during the very important SATs week for Y6 to support the children and ensure these tests are well managed.

We will be keeping the situation under review and ensure that Crudgington Primary continues to flourish with the support of the Trust and staff at the school.
